Domain	Identified Risks
Peer / Individual	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friends who engage in the problem behavior • Favorable attitudes towards the problem behavior
Family	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family management problems • Favorable parental attitudes & involvement in the problem behavior
School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth receive conflicting messages about substance use acceptability • Favorable or unclear expectations regarding substance use from parents
Community	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community laws & norms favorable toward drug use • Availability of drugs (perceived availability) • Transitions and mobility • Low neighborhood attachment (in some groups) • Economic deprivation (in some groups)
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids with lots of money • Lack of spiritual engagement in youth • No support for good kids • Stigma for seeking treatment • Lack of dedicated prevention resources • Island issues (geographic isolation, lack of alternative activities)
