VIDEO SPOT GUIDELINES

Goal: To 'Promote Healthy Decision-Making' among your peers.

How you interpret and convey the goal is up to you. Your ideas should be yours. Do not use another spot from television, the Internet or another media outlet. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.

You may work alone or as part of a team. All members of your team must be in the specified age group (grades 6 through 12) and must be listed on the entry form that is available in the CPS and NHS Principals' Offices. Additional entry forms may be used if needed.

Entries are **due by Friday, November 20th at Noon** in the Principal's Office at Nantucket High School.

Winners will be announced in December. The decisions of the judges are final.

Please note the following guidelines for the making of your video.

- 1) Submission must be in the form of a viewable video. Digital or DVD formats are acceptable. For questions, please speak with Mr. Thompson.
- 2) The video must be between 45 and 70 seconds in length.
- 3) There must be no violence, nudity, foul language or 'hand signs'. (Keep it rated PG or lower.)
- 4) No person, animal or other living thing shall be injured in the video or in the making of the video.
- 5) The names or likenesses of any actual person may not be used in your video unless said person has given his/her consent.
